Theme: Stop the Plastic Soup

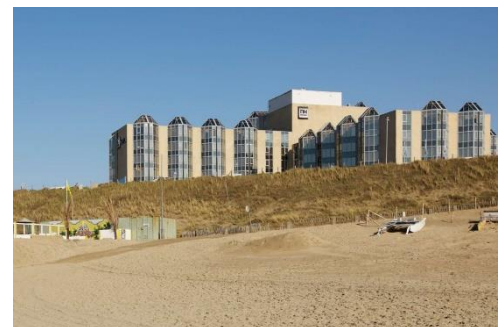
The Plastic Soup in our seas and oceans is becoming more visible and also more problematic. The plastic waste floating around there comes from human action: the waste we throw away on the street, fishing nets that stay behind, but also by washing synthetic clothing or by brushing your teeth. All these different types of plastic form a mass of plastic particles together in seas and oceans. Due to weathering, sunlight and waves, it breaks apart into small pieces and this leads to serious environmental pollution in the life cycle.

During this seminar vocational teachers will be inspired and start eTwinning projects about Plastic Soup.

From Schiphol Airport

Train

A train departs every 30 minutes to trainstation 'Zandvoort aan Zee'. (7,40 euro one-way). This takes about 45 minutes. You have to get the train to 'Amsterdam' and switch to the 'sprinter' (smaller train) to 'Zandvoort aan Zee'.

Taxi

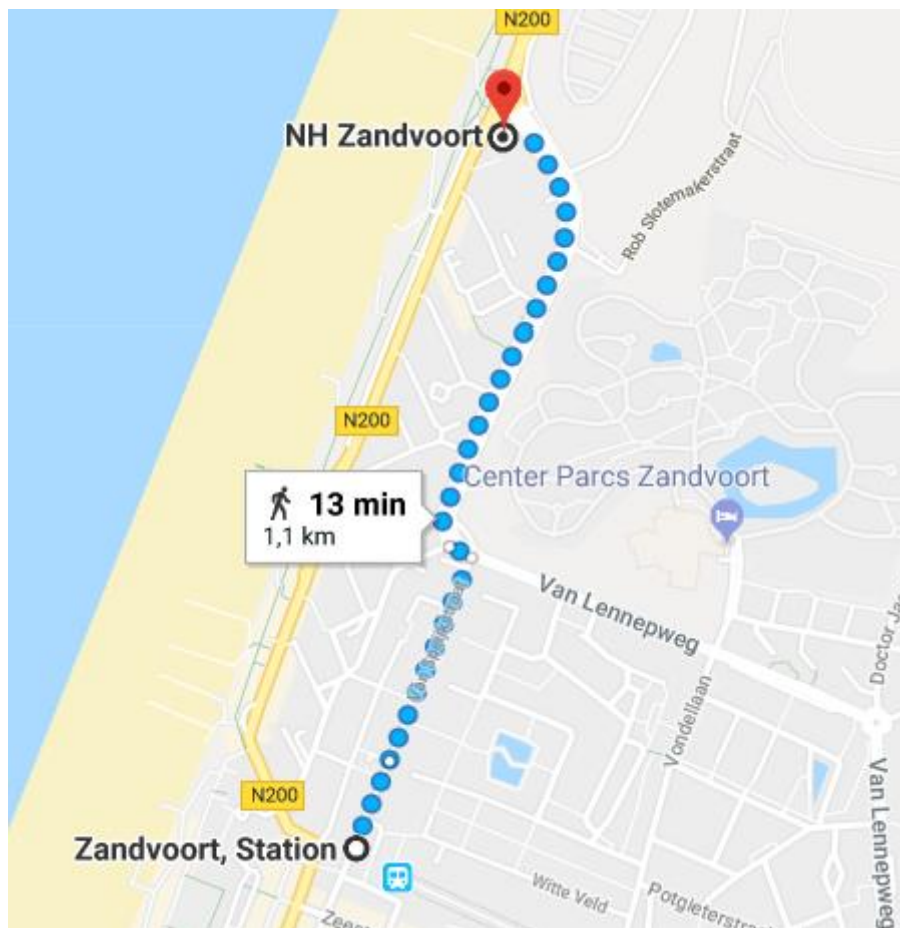
A taxi ride from the airport takes about 35 minutes and is (around 80 euro).

From train station Amsterdam Central

A sprinter (small train) departs every 30 minutes, directly to trainstation 'Zandvoort aan Zee'. This takes about 30 minutes. From trainstation 'Zandvoort aan Zee' it is a 13 minute walk to the hotel **or** you can take bus 81 and get out at 'Circuit' (1,02 euro).
